TCC's works on MRV for transport sector

Motivation and approaches:

- Global dialogue on climate change commits each country to plan mitigation actions for reducing GHG emisisons. Thailand also pledged a NAMA road map, and INDCs in the UNFCC conference to show the country's contributions.
- As specified in the ASEAN Transport Strategic Plan (2016-2025), sustainable transport is included as key goal to promote low carbon modes of transport.
- In Thailand, there are many master plans that need a good monitoring system to measure the GHG emissions and effectiveness of the sustainable transport policy for transport sector, such as Thailand Climate Change Master Plan, Environmental Sustainable Transport Master Plan, and Energy Efficiency Plan.

Activities

- Report "Monitoring transport GHG emissions in Thailaand" to explore the current situation of the available transport data, data gaps, and recommendation for the improvement.
- Capacity building for governmental officers by organising workhshops and training courses.
